## Earth Day Paper Plate Weaving

Paper plate weaving is a fantastic fine motor challenge. With Earth Day right around the corner, this simple paper plate weaving craft activity is a fun way to spark discussion with your residents about stewardship of the earth while encouraging creativity!

## Materials Needed:

- Paper plate
- Yarn (various colors optional)
- Scissors

## Instructions:

- 1. **Prepare the plate:** Cut a small slit on the edge of the paper plate.
- 2. **Start weaving:** Insert one end of the yarn through the slit.

## 3. Weave back and forth:

- Pull the yarn through the slit, creating a loop.
- Weave the yarn over and under the existing yarn, crisscrossing it.
- Continue weaving, pulling the yarn tight enough to hold the weave but not so tight that it breaks the plate.
- 4. **Secure the edges:** Once you've covered the plate with yarn, cut the remaining yarn and secure the end to the back of the plate.
- 5. Add details (optional): You can use different colored yarn to create patterns or designs on your woven earth.
- 6. **Decorate (optional):** Once the weaving is complete, you can decorate the woven earth with paint, markers, or other craft supplies.
